Everything must be included in order to have your application be considered complete for review.

- Introduction: Students must provide a 1-2 minute video—OR—a minimum one-page essay introducing him/herself. The video or essay should include interests, hobbies, values, and identify personal goals and academic goals motivating interest in PCIA.
- Most recent unofficial transcripts
- Attendance records
- Behavior records, if applicable
- Current IEP/504 plan, if applicable
- A recent academic essay submitted for a letter grade at student's most recent school. ***If an academic essay is unavailable, please write a 2-3 page essay on a research subject of your choice.*
- A letter of recommendation from a school counselor, advisor or teacher

Next Steps

After successful submission of the enrollment application and supplemental forms, the following steps will occur:

Review of student academic history: The Dean of Students will contact the student's current school counselor to review their academic history, attendance records, academic promise, motivation, character, leadership and school participation.

Admission determination: Students and parents/guardians will be notified of admissions determination by email or phone.

Finalize schedule: Student schedules are created based on transcripts, math/writing scores, and input from the student and their family.
